What is Contemplative Practice?

- > Contemplative leaders reflect on their own leadership through the lens of faith
- > Contemplative leaders make decisions with the heart and mind of the Church
- > Contemplative leaders give witness to the Gospel through their leadership

The Three levels of reflection in contemplative leadership

> Technical Reflection:

➤ What is going on?

> Interpretive Reflection:

What is being communicated by what is going on?

> Critical Reflection:

> How does my faith guide my decisions and/or reactions to what is going on?
